Black Powder Range Match Descriptions

Traditional Muzzle Loader Match:

Muzzle loader matches are held the second Sunday of the month January through December unless noted otherwise on the schedule.

Match requirements: Rifle using black powder and having flint or percussion side-lock, open sights shooting a patched round ball. Targets are hung at distances from 10 to 75 yards.

Cowboy Action Match:

Cowboy action matches are held the third Sunday of the month March, April, May, June and September unless noted otherwise on the schedule.

Match requirements: (4 firearms are required) One lever or slide action rifle shooting a pistol caliber cast lead bullet of 38 or larger caliber using smokeless or black powder.

One pump, side by side or lever action shotgun shooting low brass or equivalent shells loaded with #7.5 or smaller shot using smokeless or black powder. Two pistol caliber revolvers shooting a cast lead bullet of 38 or larger caliber using smokeless or black powder, cap and ball revolvers are permitted as are rifles shooting black powder or black powder substitute. We also shoot a derringer, if you don't have a derringer one is usually available from another shooter. We understand the cost for someone starting out so accommodations can be made for the use of 22 cal rim-fire revolvers or rifle and also for shooters under 18.

Targets are mainly steel at distances from 10 to 15 yards with occasional long distance rifle shots out to 75 yards. We permit double action revolvers if they are fired single action and modern double barrel and pump action shotguns but no semi-automatics, we can also accommodate people who do not have a holster or double- rig holster.

Cartridge Match

Cartridge matches are held the last Sunday of the month March through September unless noted otherwise on the schedule.

Match requirements: <u>Black Powder and Smokeless Powder classes.</u> Rifle; single-shot, lever or slide action (semi-automatic rifles are not permitted) shooting a lead bullet and loaded with black or smokeless powder.

Targets are steel, frangible or paper at distances from 25 to 100 yards.
