2026 HIGH POWER RANGE SCHEDULE

All events are held on Sunday mornings

January 4th through February 1st – Vintage Military Service Rifle Offhand League

February 8th through March 8th – High-Power Rifle Offhand League

March 15th through April 12th – AR-15 Offhand League

June 14th – Three-Gun Match

July 12th – Military Rifle Bench Rest Match

August 9th – IBS Target Bench Rest Match

September 13th – Ground Hog Shoot

October 11th – Three Gun Match

November 8th – Ground Hog Shoot

December 13th – IBS Target Bench Rest Match

Offhand leagues are shot on Sundays and run for five weeks each beginning the first Sunday in January. Monthly benchrest matches are held the second Sunday of each month beginning in June.

All leagues and matches start at 9:00AM and end at Noon.

Fees: \$15 for Military Service Rifle, High-Power and AR-15 leagues. \$5 for all other matches.

Participation in any of our leagues or matches will satisfy the Civilian Marksmanship Program's "marksmanship activity" requirement which is a prerequisite to purchasing an M1 Garand or other rifles from the CMP.

General Rules/Descriptions:

Military Service Rifle League: 100 record shots from the offhand (standing) position over five weeks using any military service rifle of 6mm caliber or larger. As-issued Iron/open sights only, although M1 Garand and M14/M1A rifles may use National Match sights. No slings, shooting jackets or other artificial means of support may be used.

High-Power Rifle League: 100 record shots from the offhand (standing) position over five weeks using any rifle of 6mm caliber or larger. No limitations on type or power of sights. No slings, shooting jackets or other artificial means of support may be used.

AR-15 Rifle League: 100 record shots from the offhand (standing) position over five weeks using any AR-15 platform rifle chambered in any centerfire caliber. Iron/open sights only using standard ghost ring/peep rear and post-style front sights. No scopes, slings, shooting jackets or other artificial means of support may be used.

Groundhog Shoot: 10 record shots from the bench rest position at paper groundhog targets. Classes will include centerfire varmint and hunter, rimfire varmint and hunter, iron/open sights and bench rest.

IBS Bench Rest Match: 10 record shots from the bench rest position at paper bullseye targets. Classes will include centerfire varmint and hunter, rimfire hunter and varmint, iron/open sights and bench rest. Scoped rifles will shoot at standard IBS 100 yard bench rest targets and Iron/Open sight rifles will shoot at MR-31C (5" bullseye) targets.

Military Rifle Bench Rest Match: 10 record shots from the bench rest position at a paper bullseye target using military service rifles. Classes will include Issued Sights rifles (rifles with original, as-issued sights), Any Open/Iron sight class (rifles utilizing non-issued sights only) and AR-15 class (rifles built on the AR-15 platform). No scopes. Issued Sight and Any Iron/Open sight classes will shoot at a TQ-4 (8" bullseye) target and AR-15 class shooters will shoot at an MR-31C (5" bullseye) target.
