WHO WE SERVE

With a total of **33,763 members**, the YMCA reaches people of all ages and backgrounds:

- 16,498 male members
- 17,285 female members
- 11,254 youth (ages 0-18)
- 16,003 adults (ages 21-64)
- 5,220 seniors (65+)
- 12,090 community members supported with free food

Our programs promote wellness, safety, education and joy:

- 6,804 individuals participated in Aquatics programs
- 1,510 youth engaged in enrichment and sports programs
- 230 individuals completed life-saving CPR training
- 6,348 children attended YMCA Summer Camp 2024
- 750 children warmed with new winter coats

As a nonprofit organization, we operate with transparency, stewardship, and a commitment to reinvesting in our mission. In the past year:


