Mealtime Information

- We do not accept food deliveries such as door dash or Uber eats for the children.
- To maintain safety, refrain from sending in glassware for drinks or containers.
- . Additionally, We will not serve anything with peanuts/tree nuts due to child allergies in the classrooms.
- Choking hazards that will not be served are full size grapes, or popcorn.
- No heat up lunches on your child's swim day.





