

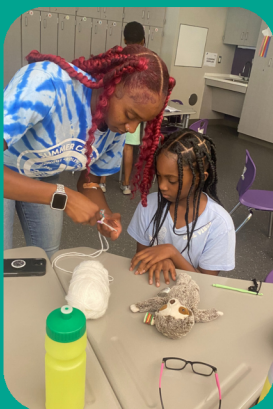

Day Camp

(Children who Completed K until entering 7th Grade)

Specialty Camps

(Ages Vary – Check Weekly Offerings)

PCA/One-on-One Support

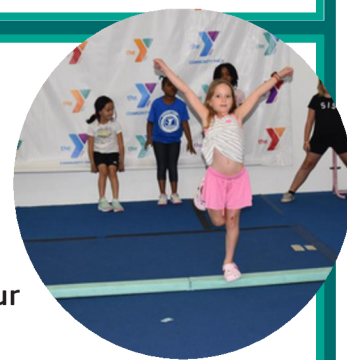
If a child has a one-on-one resource that provides services throughout the day during the school year, that person is required to be present in the camp program and wear proper photo ID. In the event your child's PCA is not able to attend, a substitute must be provided for your child to attend the program.

Expulsion & Suspension Behavior Guidelines

To reduce or eliminate expulsion and suspension we aim to maintain:

- Positive climates and focus on prevention of expulsion or suspension.
- Clear, appropriate and consistent expectations and consequences to address disruptive child behaviors.
- Open verbal and documented communication with family members following our behavior policy.

YMCA CAMP DIRECTORS MAINTAIN THE AUTHORITY TO REMOVE ANY CHILD WHOSE BEHAVIOR POSES A SERIOUS RISK OR THREAT TO THEIR OWN HEALTH AND SAFETY, AS WELL AS THAT OF OTHER CHILDREN OR STAFF, WITHOUT ADHERING TO THE PROCEDURES OUTLINED IN OUR BEHAVIOR POLICY. ADDITIONALLY, VIOLATIONS OF OR FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH YMCA POLICIES MAY LEAD TO WITHDRAWAL FROM THE PROGRAM.

***Non-refundable deposits in the amount of \$35/week are required to reserve your child's space in each week of camp at the time of registration.**

Deposits can not be transferred after June 1, 2026.

\$35 Deposit (All Camps) per week, per child (non-refundable):

***Financial Assistance is available for Day Camp and Sports & Games Camp. An application for financial assistance does not reserve a spot for your child, you must place deposits on each week of camp to reserve the spot. Apply online TODAY at www.cyedc.org. Applications are accepted now. Review and communication for awards will begin on March 1, 2026.**

CAMP BALANCE PAYMENTS

Camp balances are due IN FULL one week prior to camp week (MONDAY). View and Pay your camp balances online or in-person at any time.

- A \$50 Late Payment Fee will incur on the Tuesday before the camp week and will be automatically added to your account.

Balances for camp fees can be paid in four ways:

1. Bank draft: Set up automatic withdraws on payment due date(s).
2. Online Payments: Use your online membership account to pay balances at cyedc.org.
3. In Person: Visit our Lansdowne, Ridley Area or Springfield YMCA branches.
4. By Phone: Call our membership team at 610-557-9622.
