If families haven't signed up for camp yet, now is the time! With the school year ending quickly, we plan to make the most of it with plenty of fun.

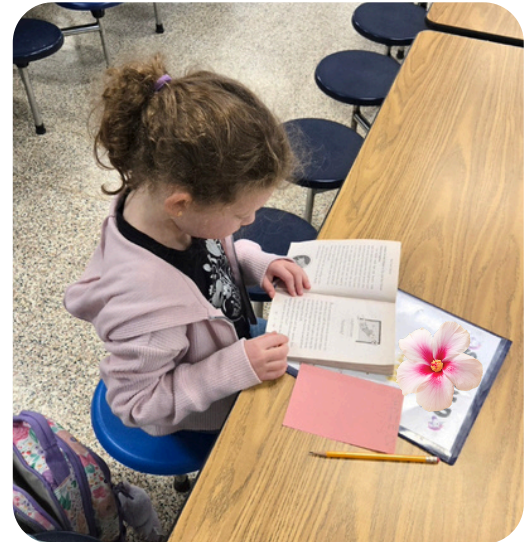
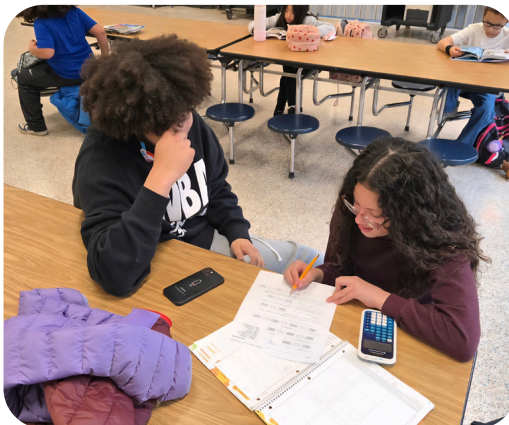
