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WHO WE SERVE

With a total of **33,848 members**, the YMCA reaches people of all ages and backgrounds:

- 16,652 male members
- 17,172 female members
- 9,172 youth (ages 0–17)
- 18,276 adults (ages 18–64)
- 6,385 seniors (65+)
- 10,606 community members, 3,225 households supported with free food

Our programs promote wellness, safety, education and joy:

- 5,850 individuals participated in Aquatics programs
- 1,809 youth engaged in enrichment and sports programs
- 648 individuals completed life-saving CPR training
- 6,421 children attended YMCA Summer Camp 2025
- 1,275 children warmed with new winter coats



The YMCA supports working families with accessible, high quality Early Learning and Out-of-School Time child care.

Early Learning Centers (ELC)

- 596 children enrolled
 - 170 children received financial aid
 - 74 through ELRC
 - 96 through YMCA Financial Assistance

Out-of-School Time (School-Age) Programs

- 1,392 children enrolled
 - 283 children received financial aid
 - 129 through ELRC
 - 154 through YMCA Financial Assistance

As a nonprofit organization, we operate with transparency, stewardship, and a commitment to reinvesting in our mission. In the past year:

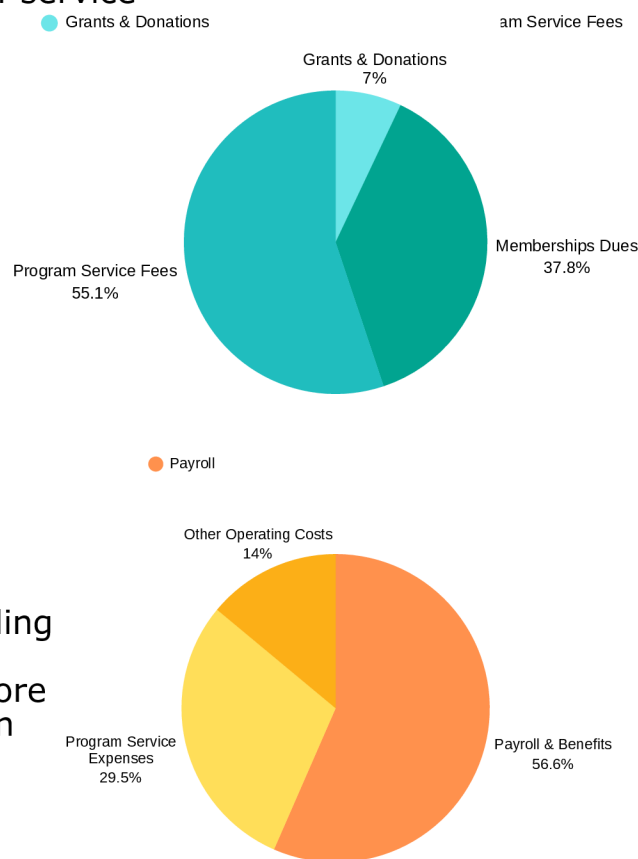
Total Revenue: \$17,018,931
